



Conference Background

•WCIT 2020 is the 23rd edition of World Congress on Information Technology targeted to **attract 4,000 high level officials, captains of industry, government leaders and academics** across 100 countries (>**300 B2B meets, 500 exhibitors, 160 international speakers)**

•InvestPenang is the state's lead agency of WCIT 2020 for Penang.








