INTRODUCTION

- The East Coast Rail Link (ECRL) project is a strategic infrastructure project envisaged to be the main backbone connection that will enable catalytic growth of economic development along the East Coast of Peninsular Malaysia.
- The overall alignment of the ECRL rail network is designed to improve connectivity throughout the East Coast region, as well as connecting it to the West Coast, while at the same time, taking into consideration the potential growth for the industrial, commercial, logistics and tourism sectors along the ECRL corridor.
- Economic Accelerator Projects (EAP) aim to increase the economic activities along the ECRL route by maximising the economic benefits and increasing traffic volumes of passenger and freight.
- States in the East Coast (Kelantan, Terengganu and Pahang) will likely receive a shot in the arm to boost the economic growth and development.










Purpose


MIDA and CCCC will cooperate for the development of the Economic Accelerator Projects (EAP) along the ECRL Corridor.


Activities @ East Coast of Peninsular Malaysia
