GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES FOR APPLICATION FOR INDIRECT EXPORT OF FINISHED PRODUCTS TO LOCAL COMPANIES GRANTED IMPORT DUTY EXEMPTION ON RAW MATERIALS AND COMPONENTS FOR EXPORT OF FINISHED PRODUCTS

- 1. Consideration for indirect export of finished products by manufacturing companies will be based on the following conditions:-
 - (i) The finished products of the applicant company are to be used as intermediate products/raw materials and components by the local manufacturing company (purchaser) to manufacture finished products for the export market; and
 - (ii) Both the manufacturing companies (applicant and purchaser) have been given import duty exemption on the raw materials and components to manufacture finished products for the export market.
- 2. Applications must be submitted <u>before indirect export transaction takes</u> <u>place.</u>
- 3. Applications should be submitted using Form PC 5 in two (2) copies to :-
