In response to the statement made by lawyer N Sivananathan in the article “New gazette needed to enforce phase 3 of MCO, says Bar” at <https://www.freemalaysiatoday.com/category/nation/2020/04/13/new-gazette-needed-to-enforce-phase-3-of-mco-says-bar/> the Attorney General’s Chambers would like to clarify as follows:

- (a) for the period from 18 to 31 March 2020, the following laws were in force:
 - (i) Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases (Declaration of Infected Local Areas) Order 2020 [*P.U. (A) 87/2020*];
 - (ii) Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases (Measures within the Infected Local Areas) Regulations 2020 [*P.U. (A) 91/2020*]; and
 - (iii) Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases (Compounding of Offences) (Amendment) Regulations 2020 [*P.U. (A) 99/2020*];

(b) for the period from 1 to 14 April 2020, the following laws are in force:

(i) Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases (Declaration of Infected Local Areas) (Extension of Operation) Order 2020 [*P.U. (A) 98/2020*];

(ii) Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases (Measures within Infected Local Areas) (No.2) Regulations 2020 [*P.U. (A) 109/2020*];

(iii) Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases (Measures within Infected Local Areas) (No.2) (Amendment) Regulations 2020 [*P.U. (A) 112/2020*]; and

(iv) Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases (Compounding of Offences) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2020 [*P.U. (A) 111/2020*]; and

(c) for the period from 15 to 28 April 2020, the Attorney General's Chambers are preparing the respective laws.
