### Kemaman Port

Located on the East Coast of Peninsular Malaysia, is one of the deepest seaports in Malaysia and a fastemerging port acting as the new gateway to the Asia Pacific Region.


The specialized industrial port shall serve to cater the heavy industry and petrochemicals plants within its vicinity, and as a catalyst for the development of surrounding hinterland of Terengganu.

### Kemaman Port Services

#### Labor and Rigger

Skilled and experienced manpower to support other vessel operation including mobilization and demobilization of equipment and gears for offshore project

### Other ancillary and additional services

Fresh water supply, bunkering and garbage collection

#### Supply of Equipment

- Supplying of cargo handling equipment and gears
- Bulk cargo handling equipment

#### Port Safety and Security

- Compliance with international ship and port security (ISPS Code) requirement
- Emergency Response Planning (ERP) to ensure safety and security in port
- Accredited ISO 9001:2000 for "Port Services Covering Bunkering, Towage, Pilotage, Cargo Handling, Stevedoring and Warehousing"



#### Port Navigational Control

Control of navigational activities within Kemaman Port Limit

#### **Marine Services**

Efficient pilotage and towage services, mooring and unmooring services for berthing and unberthing of vessels

#### Cargo Handling Services

Loading, unloading, lashing, receiving and delivery of various type of cargo

#### **Stevedoring Services**

- Stevedoring services for break bulk and general cargo
- Dry bulk cargo handling

#### **Storage Facility**

- Warehouse (5,000 m2)
- Open yard (4 ha)
- Concrete yard (10,000 m2)

North KTCC is a state of the art development stretching for about 1.4 kilometres along the Kuala Terengganu shoreline. It is located in the heart of Kuala Terengganu, connected by the iconic landmark of Terengganu Drawbridge.

The urban oasis will consist of 4 Districts i.e., KTCC Oceanfront, KTCC Creek, KTCC Avenue and KTCC Business Park. The city is designed to accommodate more than 50,000 people in residential towers and villas.
