Johor Corporation (JCorp) was incorporated as Perbadanan Kemajuan Ekonomi Negeri Johor (PKENJ) by the Johor State Government under Enactment No.4/1968 (*Enakmen Perbadanan Johor No.4/1968*) which was passed on **18 May 1968** as the principal development institution to drive the growth of the state's economy. It was later amended in 1995 and renamed to **Johor Corporation** (*Pindaan; Enakmen No.5/1995*).
