## **Definitions**

## 1. Evaluation Fees

**Evaluation Fees is a fee imposed to all applications** that requires screening, evaluation process, recommendation and approval from CEO/Committee/Meeting and issuance of documents/status.

The evaluation fee is imposed to cover MIDA's operation costs in the evaluation process of the applications.

These fees apply to **applications** such as:

- Manufacturing licenses
- Tax incentives
- Duty tax exemptions
- Grant disbursements
- Other post-approval-related applications.

## 2. Issuance Fees

Issuance fees is a fee imposed for the issuance of RE/RO status, Annual Compliance Report/Assessment, Certified True Copy (CTC), Duplication of ML and MIDA Supporting Letter that requires screening, processing, producing and delivering the requested documents/status.

The fees are imposed to cover MIDA's administrative cost incurred during the process of the issuance of requested documents/status

## **Applicable documents** include:

- RE/RO status certifications
- Annual Compliance Reports/Assessments
- Certified True Copies (CTC)
- Duplications of Manufacturing Licenses (ML)
- MIDA Supporting Letters
