1. Evaluation Fees

Evaluation Fees is a fee imposed to all applications that requires screening, evaluation process, recommendation and approval from CEO/Committee/Meeting and issuance of documents/status.

The evaluation fee is imposed to cover MIDA's operation costs in the evaluation process of the applications.

These fees apply to **applications** such as:

- **Manufacturing licenses**
- **Tax incentives**
- **Duty tax exemptions**
- **Grant disbursements**
- **Other post-approval-related applications.**

2. Issuance Fees

Issuance fees is a fee imposed for the issuance of RE/RO status, Annual Compliance Report/Assessment, Certified True Copy (CTC), Duplication of ML and MIDA Supporting Letter that requires screening, processing, producing and delivering the requested documents/status.

The fees are imposed to cover MIDA's administrative cost incurred during the process of the issuance of requested documents/status

Applicable documents include:

- **RE/RO status certifications**
- **Annual Compliance Reports/Assessments**
- **Certified True Copies (CTC)**
- **Duplications of Manufacturing Licenses (ML)**
- **MIDA Supporting Letters**
