MALAYSIA'S GDP EXPANDED BY **5.2% IN 2025**, THE STRONGEST GROWTH IN THREE YEARS, ACCELERATING TO 6.3% IN THE FOURTH QUARTER, THE FASTEST PACE IN TWELVE QUARTERS

THE RINGGIT'S TRAJECTORY TELLS A PARALLEL STORY. HAVING GAINED APPROXIMATELY **17%** SINCE THE START OF 2024, IT STANDS TODAY AS **ASIA'S BEST-PERFORMING CURRENCY**, TRADING AT ITS STRONGEST LEVELS IN EIGHT YEARS AGAINST THE US DOLLAR




